(Completion requirement) This Program requires a student to study for two years or more. During this period, it is expected to obtain necessary credits from courses that this Program requires for completion. In addition, a student needs to obtain necessary research supervision for master's thesis, receive evaluation, and pass the final exam. However, those who accomplished outstanding research achievements may complete the Program after studying for one year or more in this Program. Students must earn at least one credit from the listed "Graduate General Education Courses (大学院共通科目)" and "Degree Programs' Common Courses (研究群共通科目)" in the specialized foundation courses respectively designated by the degree program. For the information of "Graduate General Education Courses (大学院共通科目)", please refer to the list of courses provided in the guidance materials.

(Note) As part of this Program's completion requirement, it may recognize maximum 10 credits a student obtains from courses that are offered in other programs as long as this Program deems it to be educationally beneficial for this student.
