To all students

[COVID-19 Updates] Refrain from Extracurricular Activities Held Outside of the City (REQUEST)

According to the fact that 1) IBARAKI Governor raised the COVID -19 alert level from 2 to 3 and 2) designated Tsukuba and other 15 town/cities as the region where needs special precaution (感染拡大市町村 - kansen kakudai shicho-son), the University decided to take additional measures for school activities.

Regarding extracurricular activities, we have asked you to follow the measures / guideline to resume your activities (announced on June 22nd), however, here we again request you to put all activities outside the city on pause during the period that we (Tsukuba citizen) are requested to refrain from nonessential & non-urgent outings.

1. **Suspension Period:** **From July 30 to August 12**

*The period may get extended depends on the period IBARAKI has set.

2. **The Activities to be Suspended:** **All ACTIVITIES held OUTSIDE Tsukuba**

(including match, joint practice, and training camp)

*Activities that involves external users from outside the city

[Exception] The following activities are permitted even during the above period;

- Participation in matches / leagues that are held by the proper organizations; which are responsible to manage / control their own activities (ex. Official matches / leagues).

Note: In case of the event that involves “overnight stays” or “many and unspecified number of participants / audience,” the clubs / circles representative must apply for a special permission following the guidelines; “団体活動開始ガイドライン (Guideline for Re-Starting Activities)” and “団体活動に関する申合せ (Arrangements on Group-Activities).”

○**Practical Match & Joint Practice**

According to the request issued by the IBARAKI, the University of Tsukuba set some rules /guideline for conducting / participating practical match and joint practice as below.

- Any match / game you play against the team that their school (university, etc.) locate in the area of “緊急事態宣言 State of Emergency” or “まん延防止措置 Focused Anti-infection Measures” should be cancelled.
- Practices with the teams that their school (university, etc.) locate in the area of “感染拡大市町村 (the region where needs special precaution)” should also be cancelled.
- A practical match should have no more than 2 teams(schools)

*If you are scheduled to participate in a practical match, please have 14-days health monitoring prior to the activity.

さて、県では、新型コロナウイルスの新規陽性者数が急拡大している状況を踏まえ、緊急事態措置等の判断指標「茨城版コロナ Next Ver. 3」に基づく県の対策 Stage について、今般、Stage 2 から Stage 3 に引き上げるとともに、感染拡大市町村の指定を行いました。

つきましては、新型インフルエンザ等対策特別措置法第24条第9項に基づき、下記による対策を要請いたします。

○練習試合や合同練習について（7月30日（金）以降）

- ・ 緊急事態宣言や、まん延防止等重点措置区域に所在する学校との練習試合等は、自粛
- ・ 感染拡大市町村に所在する学校との練習試合等も、自粛
- ・ 練習試合等を実施する場合は、自校を含め2チーム以内
※練習試合等に参加する学生は、2週間前から毎日の健康観察を徹底
